




Figure 1.2 View from the year



### 2.6.1 View from the front

- Infrared lens
- 2. Camera lamp
- Visual camera
- 4. Laser
- 5. Trigger
- 6. Battery

### 2.6.2 View from the rear

- 1. Touch screen
- 2. Power on/off
- 3. Menu
- 4. Back
- Navigation keypad
- 6. Attachment point for wrist/neck strap
- 7. Attachment point for wrist/neck strap

### 2.6.3 SIM card and USB

- SIM card cover
- 2. Micro SIM card slot
- USB port

## 2.7 To insert/remove the micro SIM card

Note The camera must be turned off.




Figure 2.1 Insert/remove the micro SIM card.

Insert the micro SIM card:

- 1. Loosen and remove the four T8 screws (1) to the SIM card cover (2).
- 2. Remove the SIM card cover (2).
- 3. Slide the micro SIM card into place. Make sure it goes all the way into the slot (3).
- 4. Install the SIM card cover (2).
- 5. Tighten the four T8 screws (1).

### Remove the SIM card:

- 1. Loosen and remove the four T8 screws (1) to the SIM card cover (2).
- 2. Remove the SIM card cover (2).
- 3. Give the micro SIM card a push to release it.
- 4. Remove the micro SIM card.
- 5. Install the SIM card cover (2) and tighten the T8 screws (1).

### 2.8 Quick start quide

- 1. Charge the battery.
- 2. Push the battery into the camera battery compartment.
- 3. Press and hold the Power button to turn on the camera.
- 4. Follow the instructions on the camera screen to set up the camera according to your preferences.

**Note** Select the settings as a part of the initial setup of the camera or later at any time via the Settings app.

- 5. Aim the camera toward the object, to measure a temperature. The spotmeter temperature is displayed on the screen.
- 6. Pull the trigger to save the image.

### 2.10 Flir Apps

Flir Apps provides access to both Flir-developed and third-party apps. Users can explore, try, and install apps directly from the platform.

- Apps may be free or require a separate purchase or subscription.
- A red dot will show on the Flir Apps icon in the app overview when updates are available for installed apps.
- Each app contains a details page with information such as app description. version information, supported languages, etc.

### 2.10.1 Download an app

- Open Flir Apps.
- 2. Click SIGN IN OR CREATE ACCOUNT (for first time users).
  - 2.1. Enter email address and password.
  - 2.2. Click Sign in.
- 3. Select the app to download.
- 4. Click INSTALL.

### 2.10.2 Update an app

- 1. In the app overview, a red dot indicates apps with available updates.
- 2. Open Flir Apps.
- 3. Select the app with an available update.
- 4. Click INSTALL

### 2.10.3 Third-party apps

These apps may require a separate user account and may be free or paid.

To download third-party apps, see section 2.10.1 Download an app.

## 2.11 Disposal of electronic waste
